Computer Protection

Your computer is an investment containing your valuable data and should be protected accordingly. The Monfort College of Business Technology Committee recommends the following security guidelines:

- Keep all software up-to-date with the manufacturer patches or service packs.
- Enable Microsoft™ "Automatic Update" and virus automatic update.
- Install and maintain an anti-virus software package and consider installing and maintaining a spyware detection software package.
- Do not leave laptops in open, unattended areas or computer labs.
- Back up data regularly (e.g. flash drives, BearDrive, SkyDrive, or DVD). Do not leave backup data in the same location as live data.
- Consider security devices such as steel cable, locks, security plates, alarms, tracking technologies, or new biometric technologies.
- Consider homeowner or renter insurance for your computer.

MAINTAIN YOUR COMPUTER

Properly maintained computers that do not meet the shown recommendations will in most cases be sufficient to complete MCB assigned coursework.

Regardless of the type of computer you own, your academic experience at the Monfort College of Business will be enhanced through the use of computing technologies.

The purchase of a computer is not mandatory. The Monfort College of Business and the University of Northern Colorado maintain up-to-date open access computer labs loaded with all of the necessary software, Internet connections, electronic resource access, printing and projection capabilities. These labs are conveniently located in Kepner Hall and are available for all students use. This brochure provides helpful guidelines and information for students that either own a computer or are considering purchase of one. The Monfort College of Business recommends a laptop or desktop computer that meets the minimum specifications, detailed in this brochure. Students that currently own a computer should maintain the equipment in good working order. This can be done through regularly updating the operating system, productivity tools, virus protection and business specific software. Physical RAM upgrades or computer servicing to check for virus and spyware, etc. should be considered if performance significantly degrades. 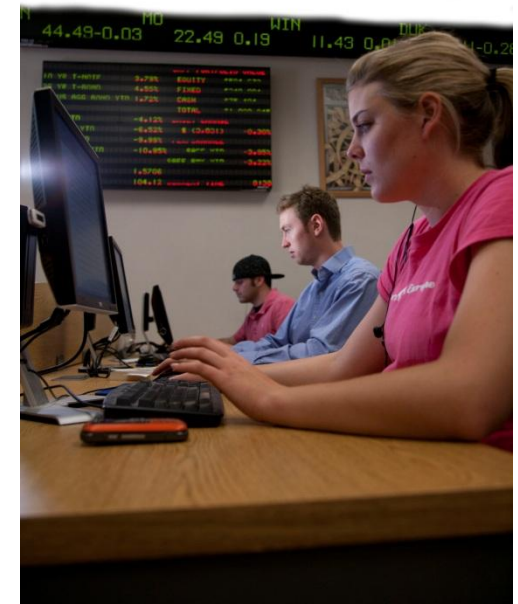


Internet and Network Access

Kepner Hall, the home of the Monfort College of Business, provides wireless Internet and network access. Wireless is available on all three floors in every room and public access area using either the 802.11g network. Network connectivity provides students with access to the Internet, limited electronic resources, printing, and online course materials. When at home it is helpful to connect with High Speed Internet (Cable Modem or DSL).

What computer to buy

Please keep in mind that these are current recommendations and are generalized to apply to all students. Due to frequent advances in technology, students should consider purchasing a computer with the most RAM, fastest processor and largest hard drive that you can afford. Whether you are using a current system you own or purchasing a new one, a computer with both an up-to-date operating system (current service packs and patches) and antivirus program are especially important.



*Intel™ processors are recommended; however, processors such as those from AMD™ are also acceptable. Only the Microsoft™ Windows operating system is recommended by the Monfort College of Business.

Most business applications available at the Monfort College of Business are not compatible with the Apple Operating System. If you have an Apple computer, installing Windows 7 through Bootcamp or VMWare Fusion is highly recommended.
